WHO ARE WE ?

We are Együttható, a youth organisation active since 2010, working locally and internationally to support young people. Our core value is solidarity, and we focus especially on including young people with disabilities and those facing social or economic challenges.

Our work is based on non-formal learning, participation, and critical thinking. We believe in learning from each other and creating spaces where everyone feels welcome, regardless of their background, abilities, or opportunities.

We run an inclusive community space in Újpest, Budapest, where young people can meet, learn, and take part in different programmes. We also organise international mobility projects through Erasmus+ and provide youth information as part of the Eurodesk network.

Our projects bring together young people from diverse backgrounds, creating opportunities to connect, share experiences, and grow together in an inclusive and supportive environment.



WHAT IS THIS PROJECT ABOUT ?

A 16-day group volunteering where we will explore social issues, share experiences, and meet people who actively work on these topics. We will visit organisations, hear real stories, and think about what we can do ourselves. Then we will turn these ideas into something creative through street art and graffiti.

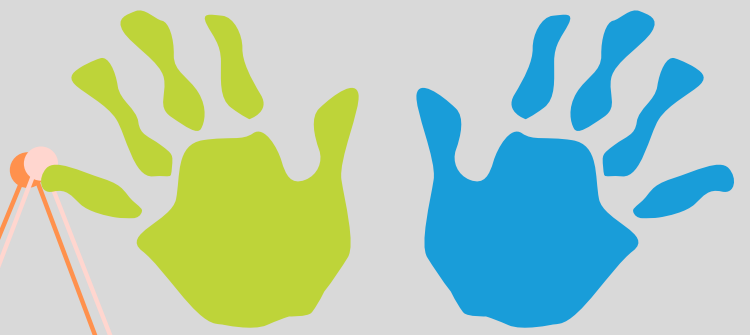
At the end, we will paint the wall of our community house (EKH) together by creating something that reflects our ideas and actually stays.

ABOUT HUNGARY



Hungary is a country in Central Europe, known for its rich culture, historic cities, and diverse landscapes. Budapest is the capital, a vibrant city with a unique mix of old and new. The Danube runs through the city, splitting Buda and Pest, and giving it a really nice vibe. You'll find beautiful architecture, chill cafés, ruin pubs, and plenty of spots to hang out with friends. The city is also famous for its thermal baths, which are definitely worth trying.

In June, summer is already in full swing, with temperatures usually around 25–30°C. The weather is perfect for exploring the city, spending time outdoors.



COST COVERAGE

Volunteers from abroad are provided with 14 EUR/day as pocket money and food expense contribution (pocket money: 7 EUR/day, food expenses: 7 EUR/day). During the project, we are organizing a welcoming dinner and an intercultural night which are covered by the project expenses.

Budapest tickets will be managed by the hosting organization. International travel is also reimbursed in exchange of bills/invoices clearly showing the volunteer's name, the cost of the given ticket and the date of the travel.

Reimbursing gasoline is also possible, contact us if you intend to come by car. But we prefer the green travel. (See the details in the next page.)





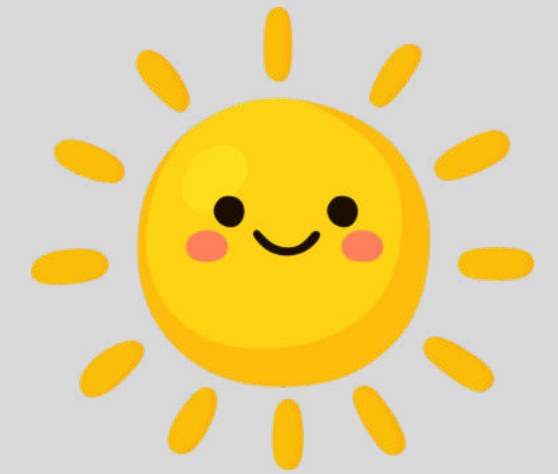
